Clemens Kaiser appointed Chief Country Officer Switzerland and CEO of Deutsche Bank (Suisse) SA

Zurich – Deutsche Bank has appointed Clemens Kaiser as the new Chief Country Officer (CCO) of Deutsche Bank in Switzerland and Chief Executive Officer of Deutsche Bank (Suisse) SA, subject to FINMA approval. He succeeds Alessandro Balestra who covered both positions ad interim after Loïc Voide left Deutsche Bank in November 2024.

Based in Zurich, Clemens will have a regional reporting line to Roberto Parazzini, Regional CEO Western Europe, and will continue his role as Head of Private Bank Central Europe & Switzerland, reporting to Arjun Nagarkatti, Head of Private Bank US & Europe International.

Holding a doctorate degree in Finance from the University of Tübingen, Clemens joined Deutsche Bank 25 years ago as a graduate trainee and held various positions since then. He joined Deutsche Bank (Suisse) SA in 2006 and has been a member of its Executive Board for the past five years.
